Daily prayer calendar

1	We provide one-to-one training for individuals going abroad in mission. Pray that we will have more opportunities to help, particularly with independent mission workers who might otherwise have gone out unprepared.
2	Our cars are constantly on the road serving UK-based mission workers while they are on Home Assignment. Pray that they will not break down.
3	We regularly organise conferences on different themes of interest to mission workers. Pray that these will go well and the right people will attend.
4	Our website has been seen by people in over 150 countries. Pray that it will be an encouragement to many more mission workers. We need more 'likes' and 'shares' to get the word out to more mission workers.
5	Networking is one of our great strengths. Pray that we'll be able to connect with the right people and connect them with others who can work together with them.
6	As we seek to grow Syzygy into a larger organisation, significant costs are involved as our overheads increase. Pray that we'll get grants and donations to help grow our income and pay additional expenses.
7	Tim frequently travels in the UK and abroad as part of his work. Pray for safety in travelling.
8	Syzygy has a unique ministry to single mission workers. Pray that this ministry will help single mission workers to thrive, and see their singleness as a gift from God and an opportunity to be free to serve.
9	We regularly provide debriefing for mission workers back in the UK for Home Assignment. Pray that we will have more opportunities to do this, and develop partnerships with agencies and churches who need support.
10	Our volunteer Barry regularly drives around the country delivering our cars to mission workers who need them. Pray for his safe travel and punctual arrival. We also need more delivery volunteers to cover times when he is not available.
11	We often go to conferences to connect, learn and share our experience. Pray that these will be times of encouragement and effective networking, meeting the right people at the right time.
12	We post daily on Facebook and skype to draw attention to mission issues and resources. Pray that more people will follow us so we can spread the news about what we're doing.
13	We are involved with several networks, forums and associations so that we can be a strategic link, bringing together different groups and people. Pray that through this there will be great cooperation in the task of world mission.
14	Many smaller mission agencies are unable to provide the level of support their mission partners need. Pray that we'll find ways of increasing our capacity to help them with this work.
15	Our Trustees are vital to the effective running of Syzygy. Pray that they'll have soft hearts to have compassion for mission workers, and hard heads to make difficult decisions.

16	Life can be much harder for mission workers if their sending churches don't enthusiastically support them. Pray that we'll have more opportunities to help churches excel at sending.
17	Many mission workers return to this country permanently and struggle to fit in. Pray that we'll connect with more of them and be effective in helping them adapt to life after re-entry.
18	Our volunteer Kathy coordinates our car ministry, taking bookings and liaising with the insurers. Pray she is effective in her organising and communicating with our mission partners.
19	We regularly run workshops on different themes relevant to world mission. Pray that these will deliver exactly what mission workers need to hear.
20	On our website we have several 'Guides to Doing Mission Well' to help prepare people for each stage of their missionary journey. Pray that the right people will find them at the right time.
21	One of Syzygy's advantages is that it is small enough to change direction quickly. Pray that we will hear God's prompting and respond rapidly to new situations.
22	Leadership training is a massive need in the world of mission. Pray for us as we seek to develop ways of helping leaders in mission – particularly in the field – grow in godly leadership ability.
23	In order to make our services available to more mission workers, we need to connect with new partners who can help us with the workload. Pray for more volunteers and for the funds to pay staff to coordinate their activities.
24	We seek to be a catalyst for innovation and development in world missions. Pray that we'll be able to stimulate meaningful discussion as we connect with others at conferences and raise issues through our blogs.
25	Many mission workers return to the UK because they suffer from stress and burnout. Pray that we will help them make sustainable lifestyle changes and get back into the mission field.
26	Our cars need to be replaced from time to time so they don't get too old and weary. Pray that we can raise sufficient funding to make big improvements.
27	We speak at retreats on issues like stress, identity and singleness. Pray that mission workers will hear from God on these issues and resolve longstanding issues in their lives.
28	We publish a new blog about mission every Monday. We've been doing this for 7 years so there are now over 150,000 words on our website! Pray that we will continue to be creatively inspired and find new things to say!
29	Managing a charity is growing ever more complicated in the UK and as Syzygy grows there is always more to do. Pray that we will stay on top of best practice and keep all our policies and registrations up to date.
30	Many mission workers burn out due to overwork and other causes of stress. Pray that we will find creative ways of helping such people learn to live well and manage their stress.
31	Many of our conversations with mission partners abroad take place using Skype. Pray that our communication will be effective despite some of the challenges of technology.
