Volunteers to work with Kapumpe Christian Primary School from September 2014 / January 2015.

Kapumpe Christian Primary School opened in January 2014 and is the first school of its kind in Ndola, Zambia. The school was birthed out of an orphan project established in 1998 which now supports around 160 orphans and vulnerable children in the local community. At present we have 3 volunteer teachers, 2 from the UK and 1 from Zambia. They have already created an amazing learning environment for the first class of children and are making a huge impact.

We are now looking for 2 enthusiastic teachers with experience in teaching Key Stage One and/or Foundation Stage to join our pioneering school. We are looking to build a strong team of teachers and leaders who can carry the school into the future and fulfil its vision to transform this community. We are committed to training and sharing good practice with other local schools. An experienced candidate who is able to provide support and supervision for our teachers would also be a real blessing.

The minimum commitment is 2 years and we would love to have you even longer!
